Dear Parent/Carer,

I would like to open my letter by wishing you all a happy New Year – and welcoming you to Kingfisher Learning Trust. To introduce myself – I am the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Trust and have worked in education for 36 years. 17 of those years have been in Oldham and I and have been Headteacher of Kingfisher Special School from January 2005 to August 2021. With Kingfisher forming a Multi-Academy Trust, my role is now leading the Trust as CEO. The reason we set up the Trust is to provide a high-quality education for a larger number of children and to this end, the Trust is planning to grow in three ways:

- with mainstream Primary Schools, reaching out to enhance practice and inclusive provision
- establishing new innovative Free Schools
- welcoming Special Schools from beyond Oldham to further develop and enrich specialist provision.

Kingfisher Learning Trust is passionate about raising standards and achievements for all and as such, we want to work in partnership with like-minded schools with a similar culture, within Oldham and across neighbouring Local Authorities. - Medlock Valley Primary School, a mainstream primary school in Oldham that joined us in September 2019
- Halcyon Way a newly built free school for primary aged children with less severe to moderate learning needs and opened January 2022.

The **Trust's Intent** is founded on respect for everyone within the Trust family by encouraging and celebrating diversity. With a creative and flexible approach based on high aspirations, there is a commitment to providing opportunities for learning in a safe, supportive environment. The Trust is ambitious for every learner to grow as an individual and develop knowledge and skills to contribute to society.
